## 1. What is this booklet about?

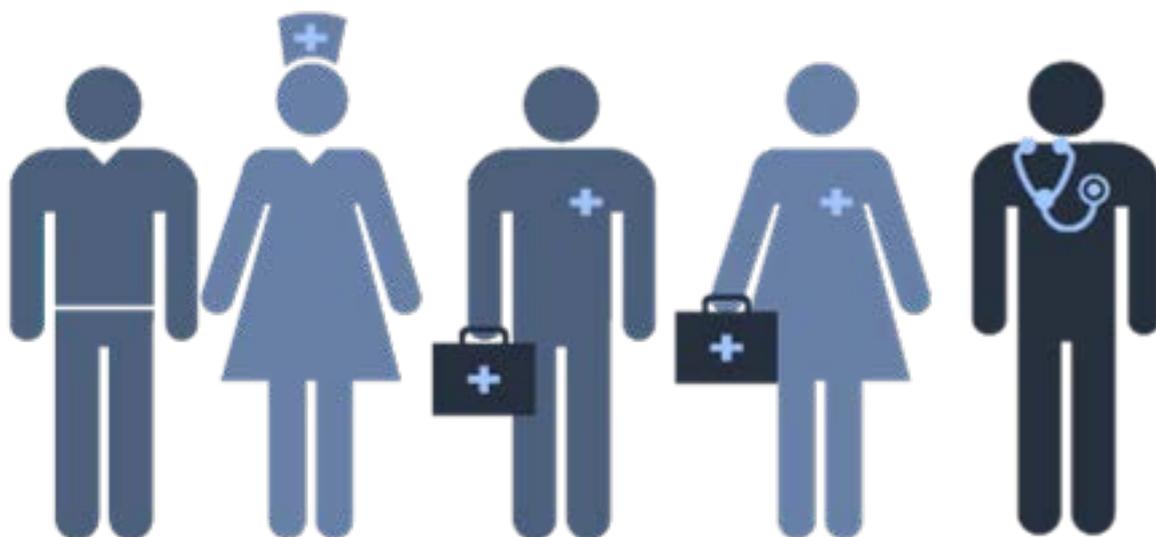
The NHS has written a plan for the next 10 years, it looks at the different things the NHS needs to do to make things better across the country.

Health & Care will:



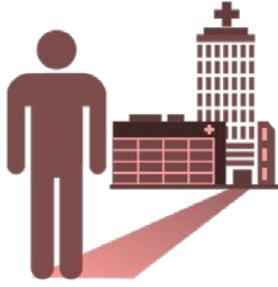
Help you to stay well, get the right care in the right place at the right time.



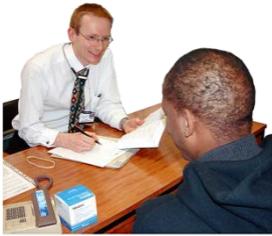
Help you to look after your health better.

Give you better access to advice from specialists and their teams.

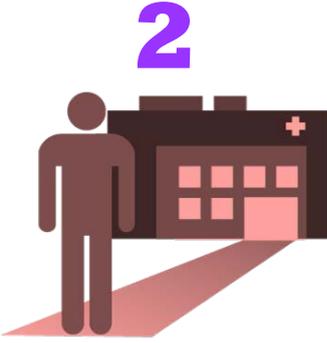


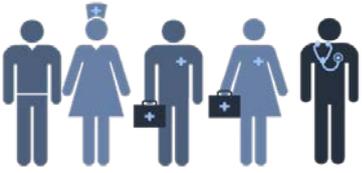
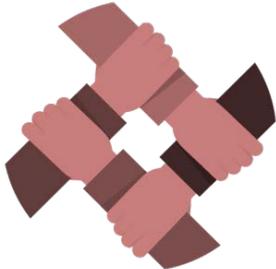
Give you access to services and advice from your computer, tablet or phone if you want to.

	<p>Support people of all ages to be in control of their own health</p> <p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• supporting more people to get a check-up at the doctor each year to keep them well.</li><li>• making sure that children and their families get the best start in life by supporting them better.</li><li>• helping people to give up smoking</li></ul>
	<p>Access the right care closer to home</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Work with the community to make services better</li><li>• Making sure that the children and young people with a complex learning disability or autism are better supported</li></ul>

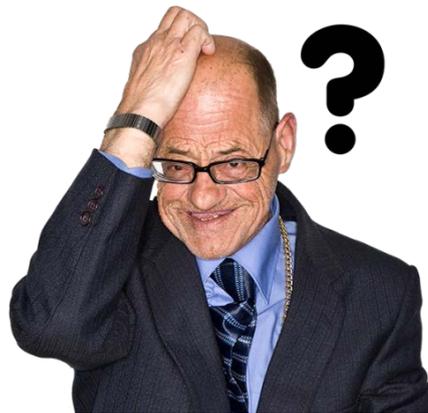
